

KEY HIGHLIGHTS - POLAND

This one-pager aims to provide a brief overview of the most salient features of Poland's national cooperative landscape, based on the detailed input provided by the membership.

Poland counts 5 ICA member organisations:

- The Auditing Union of Housing Co-operatives Zwiazek Rweizyjny Spoldzielni Mieszkaniowych RP: provides housing assistance to affiliated cooperatives.
- The National Association of Co-operative Savings and Credit Unions / Krajowa Spółdzielcza Kasa Oszczędnościowo-Kredytowa (NACSCU): represents and assists member credit unions
- National Auditing Union of Workers' Co-operatives / Związek lustracyjny Spółdzielni Pracy (NAUWC): is a voluntary and self-governing organisation, which associates labour cooperatives and other cooperative organisations in Poland.
- **The National Co-operative Council** / *Krajowa Rada Spółdzielcza* (NCC): is the apex organisation of cooperatives of all sectors in Poland. It represents Polish cooperative movement in the country and abroad.
- The National Supervision Union of Spolem Consumer Co-operatives (SPOLEM): is the national federation of consumer cooperatives.

Members are active in the following sectors:

- Real estate activities
- Construction
- Transport
- Accommodation and food service activities
- Administrative and support service activities
- Agriculture and food industry
- Human health and social work activities
- Wholesale and retail trade
- Banking
- Industry
